This scholarship is intended to assist students through the educational journey to becoming a licensed funeral director and embalmer. The Kathryn Cantillon-White Memorial Scholarship will be available two times per year. The scholarship award is \$2,000. Students who apply and do not receive the award may apply again. However, students who do receive the award may not reapply.

The Kathryn Cantillon-White Memorial Scholarship will be available for students during the Spring and Fall terms. Applicants must be enrolled as a student at FINE Mortuary College and must complete the term in which the scholarship is awarded.

The Kathryn Cantillon-White Memorial Scholarship may be paid directly to the student account at FINE Mortuary College, or if your account has a zero balance it may be paid directly to the student.

Scholarship deadlines are February 14th and August 1st.

Instructions

- Complete the Application Form and return before the deadline
- Attach a well-written, typed essay which should include your decision and choice to pursue a career in funeral service. You should also explain your life and career goals, significant people or experiences that influenced these decisions and how this scholarship will help you achieve your goals.
- Your essay should be double-spaced and a maximum of 2 pages.
- One letter of recommendation
 - Letter can be from employer, community leader, non family member, clergy, etc.
